Fire and Ice Candle lanterns

(Adult support strongly suggested)

Take a little warmth home from the Garden. Make a candle lantern to warm your fingers, light your way, or to help remember sweet times together. Here is how:

- 1) Get a can, wire, pattern and 2 rubber bands(optional-you are welcome to freestyle!)
- 2) Find a station that is open. There are a couple around. A couple are attached to the summer hand wash stations, and a couple can roam.
 Station has a wooden mallet, cork with screw for poking the holes
- 3) Wrap pattern around can and hold on with a rubber band on top and bottom



- 4) Place can over the station's branch end.
- 5) Grasp cork firmly, point tip towards a dot on pattern or can.
- 6) Bop the cork/screw end firmly with the mallet. Might take a couple bops.
 - HINT: if you want a bigger hole, bop more, or twist!
- 7) Keep on bopping, dot to dot- until you get them all.
- 8) Remove rubber bands and paper pattern (Fire+paper= uh oh!)
- 9) Poke two last holes near the top edge, on opposite sides for the handle.
- 10) Put wire through the hole and twist around itself, and again on other side.
- 11) ***ADULT JOB****Light a tea candle in the lantern.
